2. ROPE COURSE ADVENTURE (09:00 AM – 05:30 PM)

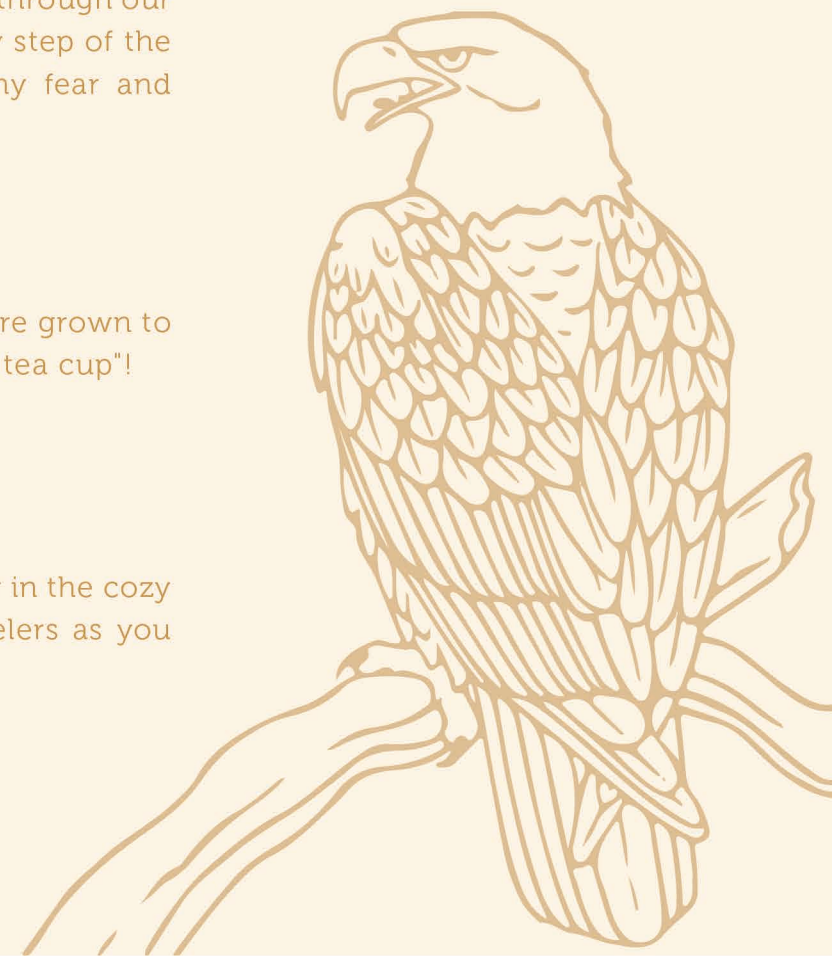
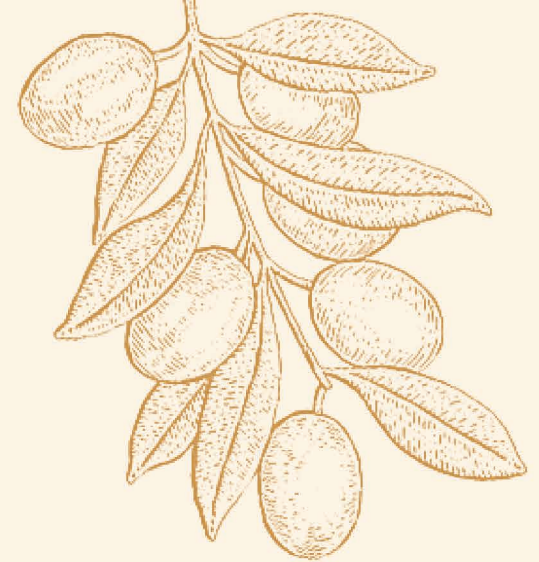

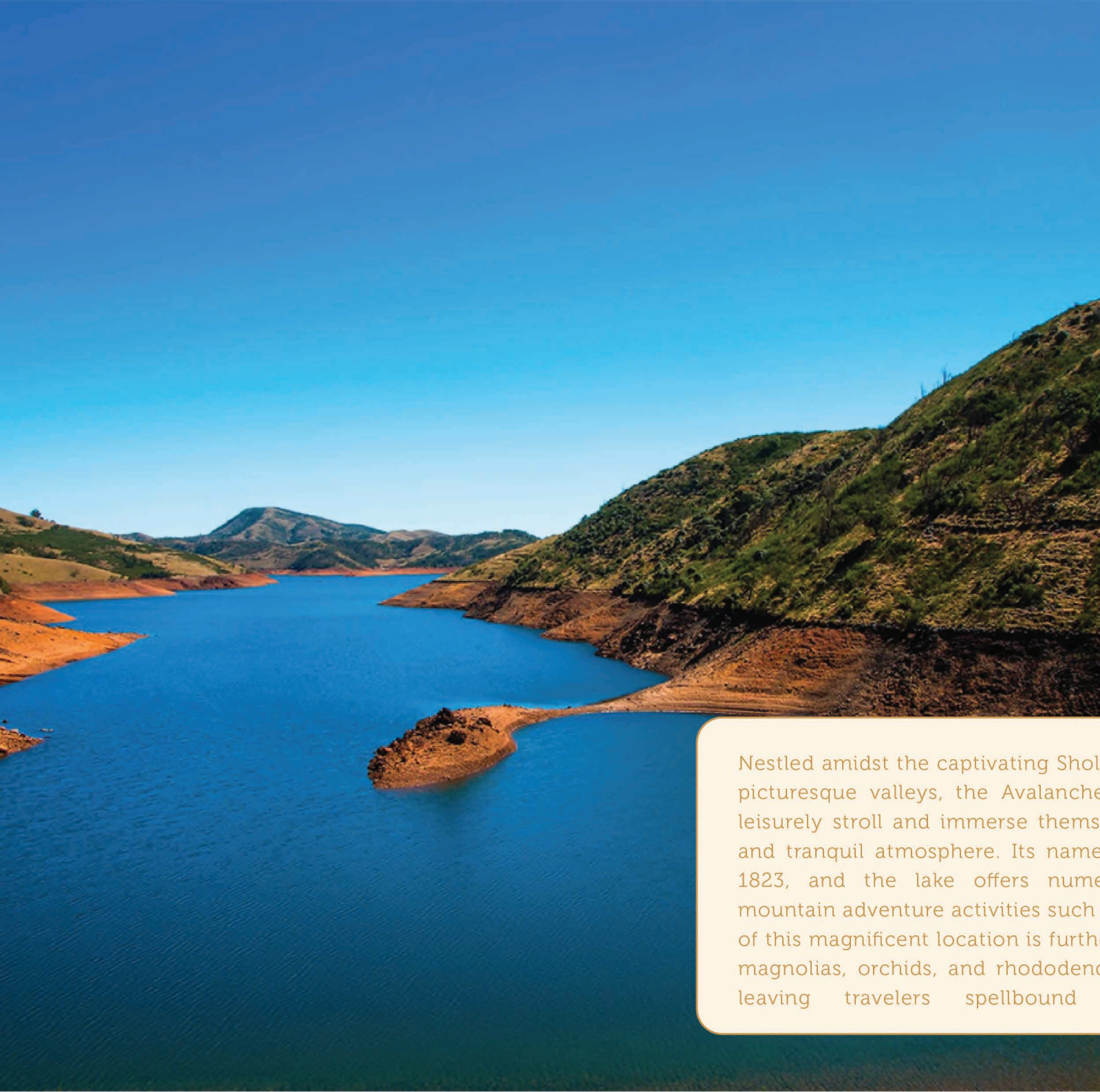

BOTANICAL GARDEN

TODA HAMLET

Despite modernization, the Todas have tenaciously preserved their customs and rituals, offering visitors a truly unique and unforgettable experience. Living in perfect harmony with nature, the Todas' way of life centers around the rearing of buffaloes and the cultivation of dairy products. Immersing oneself in their culture is an opportunity to witness a vanishing way of life, one that has endured for centuries and is increasingly rare in today's world.
